Manuscripts should be submitted exclusively to the *Information Technology, Learning, and Performance Journal*. Previously published manuscripts are not acceptable. Manuscripts are chosen through a blind review process involving the editors and selected referees. The *ITL&PJ* is indexed in the *Business Education Index*, the *Current Index to Journals in Education*, and the *Computer Literature Index*.
