- 12 point font
- Single-spaced paragraphs
- Double-space between paragraphs
- Names of all authors with email addresses
- Submit electronically as an email attachment
- Submit in hardcopy if cannot submit electronically

We need your proposal on or before October 15, 2000. Unfortunately, submissions received after that date cannot be considered for presentation.

Manuscripts selected for the refereed track will be published as either an abstract or a complete manuscript in the *Conference Proceedings*. Manuscripts to appear in the proceedings should not have been previously published or be in review for a journal.
