### Guidelines for Preparing and Submitting Manuscripts

- 12 point font
- Single-spaced paragraphs
- Double-space between paragraphs
- Cover page with names of all authors with email addresses
- Submit as hard copy **AND** on disk in Word format, **OR** electronically as an email attachment

Your proposal must be received by the Call for Papers Coordinators on or before October 1, 2001. No submissions received after that date will be considered.

Manuscripts selected for the refereed track will be published as either an abstract or a complete manuscript in the *Conference Proceedings*. Manuscripts to appear in the proceedings should not have been previously published or be in review for a journal.
