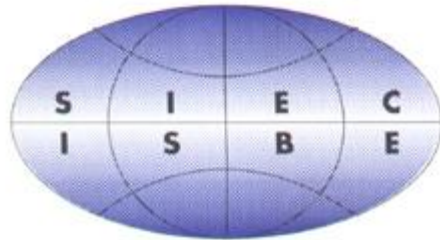

The deadline for submission of papers for the 2010 *Journal* is **November 15, 2009**. Submissions are welcomed throughout the year. A timely review will provide authors with feedback within two months. Manuscripts should be sent as an email attachment to the editor, Heidi Perreault, heidiperreault@missouristate.edu.

Topics should focus on International Business and may include reviews of literature, research, teaching methodologies, and other topics of interest to an international business educator audience. Manuscripts must not have been published or be under consideration for publication for another journal. Papers should be no longer than 15 pages (3,000 words), including references, tables, and figures. It should include an abstract. References are to be included at the end of the document. The manuscript format must follow APA guidelines.

Authors must be current members of NBEA and ISBE.
